

## **Summer Camp Scheduling Guidelines**

**Course Offerings:** Courses are offered in the morning at 9:00 AM, 10:00 AM, and 11:00 AM. Following lunch, courses are offered at 2:00 PM and 3:00 PM. Some courses are 1 hour in duration; others are 2 hours in duration, and a few last all day (5 hours).

**Course Selection:** Scouts should select the courses they need for rank advancement and courses that are interesting and fun. However, they should pay attention to recommended rank and any BSA age restrictions.

**Open Times:** It is not necessary to schedule Open Times. Open times are scheduled at 4:00 PM every day, giving Scouts the flexibility to go to any of the Areas, work on merit badges that may need extra time, participate in Troop activities, or just have FUN.

**Block Out Times:** Some Scouts may want to block out specific times in the morning and the 2 hours in the afternoon. They should select as their 1<sup>st</sup> choice the **Free Time** course offerings. This will reduce their choices of courses.
