

Advancement Roadmap

Scout

First rank – Targeted to be awarded at the May Court of Honor if starting in March, or the first Court of Honor after joining

CAPS

Troop 890 program for First Years designed to earn up to 4 merit badges and train for the Iron Eagle Triathlon and 50 mile bike ride

50 Mile Bike Ride

Usually in October, finishes off the Cycling MB, and is the highlight of the CAPS program

Second Class

Targeted to be awarded at the January Court of Honor or third Court of Honor after joining

50 Miler

For second years and older Scouts, a Spring Break campout in the Oklahoma Ouachita Mountains, with 50 miles of hiking over 4.5 days to finish the Hiking Merit Badge

Summer Camp

For First Years, trail to First Class begins here, with lots of skills development. Second Years set your own schedule to earn as many merit badges as you would like, saving time for lots of fun

Tenderfoot

Targeted to be awarded at the September Court of Honor or second Court Of Honor after joining

1st Year Winter Overnighter

In early December, a First Year-only campout to finish up outdoor requirements for Second Class rank

First Class

Targeted to be awarded at the May Court of Honor or fourth Court of Honor after joining

Star, Life, Eagle

The last three ranks are done at an individual pace, with support from your First Year Scoutmaster, and take a minimum of 16 months of tenure & leadership, 21 merit badges, 12 service hours, and the Eagle project

Except in limited and extraordinary circumstances, Eagle must be earned before the age of 18.
